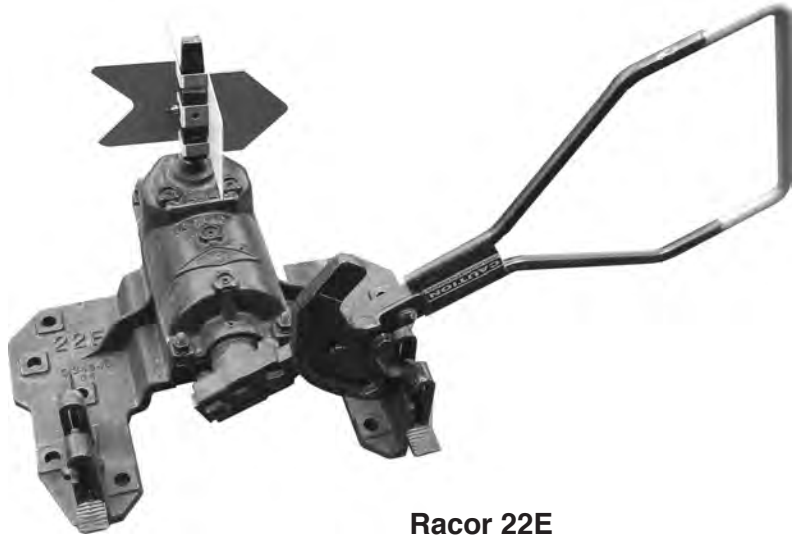




SWITCH STANDS

The Riemsarail 22E and 22EH are heavy-duty trailable switch stands designed for demanding use. The low-profile 22E is ideal for yards, ladders, and high-traffic switch turnouts where trains frequently run through switches. The 22EH uses the same base housing and operating components as the 22E but features a tall mast and target for improved visibility when required. Both models can be operated manually or trailed. When a train passes through the switch, the wheel flanges partially open the switch points, and the throw completes automatically—preventing costly damage to the stand, track, or rolling stock that could occur with a rigid stand.

The Riemsarail 36E and 36EH are extra-heavy-duty, non-trailable switch stands suitable for unrestricted applications. Both share the same base housing and operating parts. The 36E is commonly used in yard operations, while the 36EH—with its high mast and target—is well suited for mainline service.

All switch stands on this page include an adjustable connecting rod and screw eye crank, allowing precise point alignment without the need to re-spike the stand. They also feature the ergonomic “tri-handle,” a triangular hand lever positioned 30” above the ground to reduce the need for bending or lifting. Additionally, the lever’s movement range has been shortened from the usual 180° to just 120°, enabling easier and more efficient operation.
